God's Love for the World Explained

- Jn 3:16-18 God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son. He that believes in Christ's death and resurrection will have eternal life.
- Jn 3:36 He that believes not in God's Son, will get God's wrath on him. What happened to God's love?
- 1 Jn 4:7-10 Herein is God's love – not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be a propitiation (payment) for our sins.
- Romans 5:6-10 God so loved us that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for our sins. Being now justified (no longer guilty), we shall be saved from God's wrath.
- Romans 2:1-4 God's goodness, love, and long suffering – He waits for sinners to repent.
- Eph 2:4-8 God, who is rich in mercy and great love for us, even when we were dead to Him in our sins, He saved us by His grace and our faith; not of ourselves, it is a gift of God. This is how God loves the world.
- Rev 1:4-6 Jesus loved us and washed us from our sins by His own blood, and made us kings and priests unto God!
- Jn 15:12-13 Greater love has no man than this, that a man lay down his life for others. **This is his love for sinners.**

To Love God is to Obey Him

- Matt 22:36-39 The greatest commandment is to love God with all your heart, soul, and mind.
- Jn 8:42 Jesus told the Jews, If God were your Father, you would love His Son.
- Jn 14:15 **If you love Me, keep My commandments.**
- Jn 14:21 He that loves Me, shall be loved of My Father, and I will love him and will manifest Myself to him.

Jn 14:23-24	If a man loves Me, he will keep My words and obey them, and My Father will love him, and We will come unto him and make our abode with him. <u>He that LOVES ME NOT, does not obey my commandments.</u> The word you hear is not mine, but the Father's that sent Me.
Jn 15:10-11	If you keep My commandments, you shall abide in My love, even as I have kept my Father's commandment and abide in His love. Do we remain in God's love as Jesus does if we sin everyday?
1 Jn 2:3	And hereby do we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments.
1 Jn 2:4	He that saith, I know God, but keeps not His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.
1 Jn 2:5	He that keeps God's word, in him is the love of God perfected. This is how we know that we are in Him.
1 Jn 5:2-3	<u>If you love God, you also love His children. This is how we love God, when we keep His commandments.</u>
2 Jn 1:4-6	This <u>is</u> love, that we walk after His commandments.
2 Pet 3:9	<u>God is longsuffering towards us, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repent of sin.</u> We see His love in His longsuffering.
Jn 3:1 Jn 17:6-9	What love the Father has given us, that we should be called the sons of God. But the world knows us not, because it knew not Jesus. Jn 14:15-19
Jn 12:24-25	Jesus said, Unless a corn of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it cannot bring forth fruit. So he that loves his old life of pride and selfishness, must die to it to bring forth much fruit and have eternal life.
Matt 16:24-27	If any man will come and follow after Me, he must deny himself (the old life of selfishness), take up his cross of suffering, and follow Me. He that loses his old life for My sake, will find new and eternal life.

God Loves Jesus from All Eternity

- Jn 17:20-26 Father, You have loved Me before the foundation of the world.
- Jn 10:10-18 The Father loved Me, because I laid down My life, and He has given Me power to take it up again.
- Matt 17:1-5 On the mount of transfiguration, God said, This is My beloved Son, hear Him.
- Jn 15:9 -10 As the Father has loved Me, so have I loved you.
Continue ye in My love by obeying My word.
- Mark 1:9-11 Thou art My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.
- Heb 1:8-9
Prov 15:9-11
Luk 10:1 & 10-16 The Father said of His Son, You love righteousness and HATE SIN, so much so that every unrepentant sinner will be sent to hell.

Love Your Neighbor and Your Enemy

- Jn 13:34-35 A new commandment I give you, that you love one another. That is how all men will know that you are my disciples.
- Jn 15:12 & 17 This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you.
- 1 Jn 3:11-18 Christ laid down His life for us. We should lay down our lives for our brothers. If a brother is in need, help him, not in word only, but in deeds.
- 1 Jn 2:9-11 He that says, I am in the light, but hates his brother, is in darkness still.
- Matt 5:38-48
Exo 21:23-25
Exo 17:13-16 It has been said in the Old Testament, an eye for an eye and to hate your enemy. But I say unto you, do not retaliate; he that smites you on the cheek, turn to him the other also. Love your enemies and bless them that curse, hate, and persecute you. Only a real Christian will be able to love his enemy, for Jesus Christ is his example.

Romans 8:35-39 | What can separate us from loving Christ? Shall tribulation, persecution, famine, nakedness, or the sword? We are killed all day long. No, in all these things we are more than overcomers through Christ that loves us.

1 Corinthians 13:3-8: God's Children Must Practice Divine Love

1. **Love** is longsuffering: does not retaliate
2. **Love** is not envious: when your enemy prospers
3. **Love** is not puffed up: not proudful or high-minded
4. **Love** does not behave unseemly: always polite, never rude
5. **Love** is not easily provoked: not irritated or angry
6. **Love** thinks no evil: or becomes resentful and bitter
7. **Love** rejoices not: when others sin or do evil
8. **Love** bears all things: suffers all persecutions
9. **Love** endures all things: when hated and falsely accused

Matt 5:10-12 | Jesus said we are blessed when men speak evil of us, and persecute us. We will get a great reward in heaven.

God's Severity and Anger, He Will Punish All Sinners

Gen 3:17-24 | God punished His first son, Adam, for only one sin. The ground was cursed, Adam was driven from the garden, and he lost eternal life.

Gen 6:5-8	In the 1600+ years from Adam to Noah, men became very evil. God said He was sorry that He made man. I will destroy (kill) all men with a flood, but will save righteous Noah with his three sons and their wives. <u>Where was God's love for sinners? He killed millions of them!</u>
Gen 9:1	God said to Noah, Replenish (repopulate) the earth.
Gen 19:1-5 & 24-25	There lived homosexuals in Sodom and Gomorrah. <u>God rained fire and brimstone on the cities, and killed all evil sinners.</u>

	<u>From Adam to the Exodus from Egypt is about 2500 Years</u>
	God kills millions of evil Egyptians for worshipping the sun god and many other idols (gods), and for mistreating Israel as slaves.
Exo 7:19-22	<u>1st plague:</u> Nile River is turned to blood.
Exo 8:1-15	<u>2nd plague:</u> Aaron, God's prophet, stretched his hand over the river, and frogs came up and covered the land.
Exo 8:16-19	<u>3rd plague:</u> God smote the earth, and lice covered land, man, and beast.
Exo 8:20-32	<u>4th plague:</u> And the Lord brought a swarm of flies upon Egypt and ruined the land.
Exo 9:1-7	<u>5th plague:</u> God put murrain or pestilence on all cattle, camels, and sheep, and many died.
Exo 9:8-12	<u>6th plague:</u> Boils came on man and beast with much suffering.
Exo 9:23 & 27	<u>7th plague:</u> The Lord sent hail and fire upon Egypt. Any man or beast left in the open were killed. Pharaoh called Moses, <u>I have sinned. God is righteous, but we are wicked.</u>

Exo 10:12-15	<u>8th plague:</u> The Lord said to Moses, Stretch forth your hand. Locusts came up upon the land of Egypt, devouring all green things.
Exo 10:21-23	<u>9th plague:</u> Such darkness came upon Egypt that men could not see one another, but in Goshen, where Israel lived, there was no darkness.
Exo 11:1-10	<u>10th plague:</u> God killed every firstborn Egyptian. <u>Thousands died.</u>
Exo 14:22-25	God opened the Red Sea and Israel crossed over on dry ground. <u>God saved Israel that day</u> , but Pharaoh went after them into the sea, and <u>multiplied thousands of Egyptians drowned.</u>

In the 40 Years of Wandering in the Wilderness

Ps 78:40-59 Ps 106:7-40 Hosea 9:15	Israel sinned against God most of the time. The Lord got angry with His chosen people over 25 times , killing over 40,000 of them as recorded in the bible. Many thousands more, who murmured against God, were killed by snakebites. Many people count on God's love to overlook their sin against Him. Yes, His love is that he will forgive them if they repent , but God abhors or hates sinners, and will punish them. Let us believe bible records showing how God, in the 40 years, became angry with His chosen people Israel over 25 times, and killed over 40,000 sinners. <u>Where are God's judgments? Vengeance is mine, I will repay (punish), saith the Lord.</u> So, let us learn well that God will punish sinners , as the following scriptures will prove.
Exo 20:3-17	God gave Israel the ten commandments and many others. The second commandment forbid them to make any graven images.
Exo 32:1-10 & 15-19	Only a few weeks after God opens the Red Sea, Aaron makes the golden calf. God said, My wrath and anger is hot. <u>I will consume (kill) them and make from you, Moses, a new nation.</u> <u>This is the first time God wants to kill all Israel.</u>

Exo 32:25-28	The tribe of Levi was on God's side. They slew 3000 worshippers of the golden calf with the sword. The Lord plagued many others who worshipped the calf.
Exo 30:33	<u>The Lord said, Whosoever has sinned against Me, him will I blot out of My book of life.</u> So, once saved always saved? No! When you go back into sin, you are no longer saved, but a sinner again.
Exo 34:1-7	God is merciful and longsuffering, <u>forgiving sin for thousands that repent</u> , but He will by no means clear or forgive the guilty sinner, who does NOT repent.
Num 11:1-6 Ps 78:17-19	About one year later, the people complained against God saying, We want flesh to eat. God's anger was kindled. <u>He sent fire that killed many.</u>
Num 11:10 & 18-20	A few days later, they were weeping in their tents, and still wanted flesh. God heard it and became very angry . He gave them flesh for a month until they loathed it, because they despised the Lord for bringing them out of Egypt.
Num 12:1-15	Miriam and Aaron, Moses' sister and brother, said, God speaks not only by Moses, but speaks also by us. The anger of the Lord was kindled against them both. Miriam became leprous for a week for speaking against Moses, God's chosen leader and prophet.
Num 13:1-2 & 25-33 & Num 14:1-4	Twelve spies were sent out to search out the land of Canaan. After 40 days, <u>ten return with an evil report of unbelief.</u> Yes, the land flows with milk and honey, but we are like grasshoppers next to the giants living in the land. Would God we had died in Egypt!
Num 14:11-12	<u>The Lord said, How long will they provoke Me and not believe. I will kill them with pestilence, and make from you, Moses, a great nation. This is the second time that God wanted to kill all of Israel's 4-5 million people!</u>

Num 14:22-23	All the men, who have seen My miracles, the ten plagues I put upon Egypt, the opening of the Red Sea, and water from a rock, have now tempted (provoked) Me ten times, and have sinned against Me. They shall not enter the promised land.
Num 14:37	<u>The ten spies that brought an evil report, died by the plague before the Lord. Only two spies that believed God, entered the promised land.</u>
Num 16:1-3 & 12-27	Three rebel families speak against Moses saying, We are holy, and the whole congregation is holy. Why do you lift yourself above us? You have not brought us into a land flowing with milk and honey. <u>This is the third time God wanted to kill all Israel.</u>
Num 16:28-35	The Lord opened the earth, and it swallowed up the three rebel families, <u>and fire from the Lord killed another 250 rebel leaders.</u>
Num 16: 41-50	The next day, the congregation blamed Moses that the 250 rebels were killed. <u>The Lord said, I will kill all of them in a moment.</u> The plague started killing 14,700 until Moses prayed, and the plague stopped. <u>This is the fourth time God wanted to kill all Israel!</u>
Num 21:4-9	<u>The people spoke against God and Moses,</u> You brought us out of Egypt to die in this wilderness, for there is no bread nor water, and we hate this manna. <u>And the Lord sent fiery serpents to bite the people, and many died.</u>
Num 25:1- 9	After 38 years of wandering, Israel came to Shittim in Moab, opposite Jericho. There, she joined herself to false gods and committed fornication. The Lord was very angry and 24,000 died in the plague.
Num 32:10-15	God was angry with Israel. He made them wander in the wilderness forty years till the old generation, who had sinned, was consumed. The youngest man died at sixty years old (20 years old + 40 years wandering = 60 years old). If the next generation rebelled, they, too would not have entered Canaan.

Joshua, Their New Leader, Will Bring Israel into the Promised Land Warning – Warning – Warning

- Deut 4:23-27 The forty year wandering is over. **God warns the new generation, Don't break My laws and sin, and provoke Me to anger, for I am a consuming fire.** When you enter the promised land and go back into sin, I will drive you from off the good land, and will scatter you among the nations. This warning was fulfilled about 600 years before Christ when Nebuchadnezzar defeated Judah, destroyed Solomon's temple, and took thousands captive to Babylon.
- Deut 7:1-11 **Warning:** God is faithful to keep His covenant and mercy to a thousand generations, but will repay sinners that hate to keep His laws. He will destroy (kill) them.
- Deut 9:1-8 **Warning:** I am not giving you this land because of your own righteousness. No, you have been stubborn and wicked. But for the wickedness of these Canaanite nations, for their idol worship, fornication, and sacrificing of their children on the altar of Molech, I will go before you and destroy them, that I may fulfill My promise to your fathers to bring you into the land.
- Deut 28:15-29 **Warning: If you will not obey My laws, these CURSES will come upon you:** drought, defeat at the hands of enemies, all kinds of sicknesses, and famine so bad you will eat your own children.
- Deut 28:62-65 **Warning:** As the Lord has chosen you and has rejoiced to bless you, **He will rejoice to destroy you,** and to pluck you off this good land, and scatter you among the nations.
- Deut 32:16-27 **Warning:** Israel will provoke Me to anger, for a fire is kindled in My anger to punish them for sinning against Me. Since their exodus from Egypt to the time when they crucified God's Son (the law lasted 1,700+ years), they have sinned. God's warning was fulfilled a second time when the Roman Empire defeated the nation, and a remnant of Jews were scattered

over the earth. For some 2000 years, Israel had no homeland, because of their sin against God.

New Testament Grace - God Gives Man a Lifetime to Repent

Eph 2:1-3

In the past, we were sinners under the control of Satan, and were children, not of God's grace, but of God's wrath and anger.

Eph 2:4-5
Rom 5:6-8

God is rich in mercy and has great love for man, for by His grace (unmerited favour) and upon our repentance, He saves us from sin's power over us.

Eph 2:6-10

For by God's grace we are saved, and that not of ourselves, it is a gift of God.

Rom 6:1-2
Rom 3:5-8

Shall we continue in sin that God's grace would appear greater? God forbid!

Rom 6:15-18

We are made free from sin, and are now servants of holiness.

Jn 8:31-36

Jesus said to the Jews, You are slaves to sin, but I can make you free. Did Jesus speak the truth?

Where are God's Judgments in the New Testament?

God has given man a free will. He can sin his entire life and God will not strike him dead. **That is the love of God.** So, man comes to the conclusion that he can sin and escape God's wrath and judgment.

2 Peter 3:9-15
Rev 20:12-14
Rom 6:23

What man does not understand is that God is longsuffering, waiting, even if it takes a man's lifetime, for him to repent of sin. That is the love of God.
Man does not consider that God's judgment will come after he dies; for the wages of sin is death – eternal death.

God's law of sowing and reaping still operates as part of His judgment. How so?

Gal 6:7

God is not mocked. Whatsoever a man sows, while on earth, he will reap. The murderer will be jailed, the adulterer will have a broken marriage, the fornicator will get a venereal disease, etc.

1 Jn 3:4-10

Most people say that they are sinners! The bible says that sinners are children of the devil. God has given us the New Testament, that warns us over 50 times that all sinners will experience God's wrath in an eternal hell-fire.

Most people believe that sinners will go to heaven, because God loves the sinner, hating only the sin he commits. If this is true, then hell will be empty!

Matt 7:13-14

Jesus said the opposite, that the road to hell is wide and most will go there, and that the gate to heaven is narrow, and only a few will be saved.

Who will you believe, Jesus or false teachers?

God's Final Judgment in the New Testament Comes After a Man Dies.

God has given man a free will. He can sin his entire life and God will not strike him dead. That is the love of God. So man comes to the conclusion that he can sin and escape God's wrath and judgment.

2 Peter 3:9-15

What man does not understand is that God is longsuffering, waiting, even if it takes a man's lifetime, for him to repent of sin. That is the grace of God. Man does not consider that God's judgment will come after he dies. See Rev 20:12-14.

Rom 6:23

The wages of sin is death – eternal death and hell-fire.

1 Cor 6:9-10

Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate (homosexuals), nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.
