Satan deceived Israel with false doctrine to the point of killing Christ, who was the King of the Jews and their Messiah.

Jn 8:41-44 The Jews said, Our father is God, but **Jesus said, Your father is the devil**, because you are slave to sin.

Before his glorious conversion and filling of the Holy Spirit, Saul, a zealous religious Jew, **was so deceived by demon teachings**, that he unmercifully hunted down and killed followers of Christ. God showed him mercy when Jesus appeared to him on the road to Damascus, saying, Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me? **Paul forsook the religious traditions of his forefathers** and became the greatest enemy of doctrinal demons the church has ever known!

No more tossed to and fro with every wind of doctrine

Eph 4:11-15

A minister's job is to grow saints to full maturity teaching them wholesome and sound doctrine.

Gal. 5:19-21

Heresy is false doctrine or teaching. Heretics will not inherit the kingdom of God.

Acts 2:42

Continue steadfastly in the apostle's doctrine or teachings.

John 7:16

The doctrine Jesus taught was given him by His Father. It was not his own.

2 John 1:9

Anyone who sins and does not remain in the truths of Christ's doctrines cannot be saved.

How Does An Angel of Light Operate?

2 Tim 4:1-4

Some teachers come like sheep, but are really wolves in disguise. How so? By **hiding behind the word of God** teaching 90% of truth while either disregarding or changing the other 10%. Take one famous evangelist as an example. He taught about the demoniac

with the legion of demons who came worshipping Jesus longing to be delivered. Jesus cast out of him thousands of demons who then entered the pigs as per their request. Yet, this world famous evangelist never personally cast out a demon from a single convert of his. The deception was in his teaching the truth about the demoniac which led us all to believe that he himself cast out demons. My own pastor talked all the time about casting out demons, but I never saw him do it.

Moreover, he taught that every saint has the Holy Ghost, thereby leading Pentecostals to believe he was baptized in the Holy Spirit. **Yet he never taught this truth. He never taught that the baptism of the Holy Spirit is for power to do the works of Christ; that is, to cast out demons, heal the sick, and to speak with new tongues or language (Mark 16:17-20). Furthermore, he taught that sin will send one to hell and that we must live holy lives. At the same time, he would look at the camera and say, "I am a sinner just like you are." The deception is in his covering both bases at the same time.** The Baptists feel good because he relates to them as still sinning, and the holiness Pentecostals hear only that he teaches to live holy lives.

2 Cor 11:14-15

Satan inspires his false ministers to imitate Christianity and even to do miracles. Where are his ministers who are transformed into ministers of righteousness? Would they be in the churches or outside them?

The false doctrine of Roman Catholicism has deceived much of Christendom. 300 AD – 2025

Mk 16:17-20

The early days of Christianity flourished in obedience to Christ's command to preach the gospel with signs of healing and casting out of demons backing up the truths of the gospel. **Soon, however, false doctrines had to be addressed by the apostles.**

Rev 2 & 3

The apostle John, in 96 AD, warned 5 of the 7 churches **to repent of sin and to come back to true doctrinal Christianity.**

By 300 AD, false doctrines, mixed in with some gospel truths, had overtaken Christianity to become Roman Catholicism. The teaching that man is saved only through the sacraments of the Catholic Church is the most detrimental of all its false teachings.

Jn 3:3-18

Jesus said, **Unless a man is born again he cannot enter the kingdom of God.** Who is telling the truth, Jesus or the Catholic Church?

Catholicism ruled supreme. With its hierarchy of pope and bishops, anyone not conforming to its teachings **was persecuted or killed**. No seeker of truth could step outside this powerful organization to preach gospel truths until the mid 1500's. Martin Luther succeeded to break away to begin the Lutheran religion. A great truth was restored to the church. **A man is saved by faith in Christ alone.**

The false teachings of the Baptist denomination

Matt 3:1-13

The powerful, seducing, teaching demons of Catholicism still held sway over Martin Luther. He could not and would not shake them off even in the light of truths presented to him. When fellow Lutherans, seeking for more truth, spoke to him concerning water baptism of adults, he rose up in defense of infant baptism. **He persecuted these believers, who became known as Baptists.** The truth, that repentance from sin before being water baptized was necessary, was restored to the church.

Deut 12:32
Prov 30:5-6

However, Baptists failed to believe that the blood of Jesus cleanses from all sin. How so? They believe they are saved, but still sinners. They teach one of the most damaging doctrines in Christendom - that one can never be free from sin until one goes to heaven. But what does the bible teach us?

Rom 6:17-18
6:22-23

God be thanked, ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine saying you were made free from sin to

1 Tim 6:3-5	become servants of righteousness. Therefore, teach doctrine that is according to holiness.
2 Pet 1:3-11	Saints partake of the divine nature. They no longer have the sin nature.
Eph 5:26	Jesus is coming to rapture a spotless and holy church.
Eph 4:22-26 Col 3:8-10	Saints have put on the new man which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.
Luke 8:16-18	Truth and light cannot be hid. Take heed therefore to profit by the word of God, lest you hear <u>carelessly</u> and lose what you have gained and fail to be saved.
Note:	It is possible for a truly born again believer to yield himself once again to Satan, his former master. Once he makes that choice, he becomes a sinner again in need of repentance. The false doctrine stating that God sees only the blood of Christ and not the state of the sinner is a lie. Unless he is converted again from the error of his way, the death penalty for sin will have to be paid; for the wages of sin is death, not life (Rom 6:23; 1 Cor 6:9-10).

Acts 2:1-18	For about 1,600 years there was no Holy Spirit baptism. <u>In early 1900, the truth of the baptism in the Holy Spirit to do the works of Christ was restored to God's people.</u> The evidence of speaking with other tongues and miraculous physical healings came alive again. <u>The Baptists rejected this truth.</u> Doctrinal demons convinced them that miracles and tongues had ceased with the apostles. <u>Among some Baptists today, there is disdain for these truth seekers, known as Pentecostals.</u>

The false teaching in the Pentecostal Church

The teaching that the believer must be baptized into the Holy Spirit was restored to the church. Believers speak with tongues, which is good, and they send missionaries to preach this new truth to the world. It appears as though the Pentecostals have all the truth of the early church in the book of Acts. Or do they?

Deception #1	They believe that the baptism of the Holy Spirit is merely speaking with tongues. The casting out of demons and healing of the sick is rarely seen in the church. They fail to acknowledge that they lack the miraculous power witnessed in the early church.
Deception #2	<u>The power of God is believed to be present when people fall backwards</u> laying immobilized on the floor. Did this ever happen in the early church? No. Are lives being changed so that the fruit of the Spirit is evident: love, joy, peace, self-control? There <u>is</u> a power at work when people fall down and are frozen in place. <u>It is the powerful deception of Satan to convince the church that the Holy Spirit is doing a work when in fact, it is demonic.</u>
Deception #3	Well meaning Pentecostals, by saying, “God is doing miracles,” are deceived , being convinced that biblical, supernatural healings and deliverances are occurring every church service, when in fact, they are not. Instead of laying hands on the sick and casting out demons , the church sways back and forth to the worship music, waiting for the Holy Spirit to do something for them.
Rev 12:9	Where is the reality of the scripture that tells us that the devil has deceived the whole world? How has he deceived the world? Make no mistake, one of Satan’s main functions as this world’s religious leader is to deceive multitudes with false doctrine. Satan has an army of demons under his direction. Demons are <u>disembodied</u> spirits who can torment men, teach doctrines, and counterfeit the 9 supernatural gifts of the Holy Spirit. (1 Cor 12:4-8)
Gal 5:19-21	
Note!	Can a <u>disembodied</u> demon find place in a saint to dwell in? Yes! Deacon Philip cast demons out of many of his new converts and those demons came out of them screaming (Acts 8:5-8). Saints have been given power over <u>all</u> the powers of darkness, and that includes demons. The teaching that the Holy Spirit cannot live inside a saint along with demons is false. The Holy Spirit has his own body to live in. He

lives in us only in the sense of being in union with us as in 1 Cor 6:17 and John 16:20-21. He gives us power to cast demons out of ourselves and other believers whenever necessary (Eph 4:26-27).

Jesus confronted demons and cast them out.

Healing and deliverance resulted every time. The needs of the people were met. They testified about the great things God had done for them. Praise and worship of God followed, with great rejoicing!

Luke 8:1-4 Mary Magdalene had seven demons leave her. Many other women were also delivered of evil spirits. **They were all believers.**

Matt 4:23-24 Jesus preached the gospel. He then healed all manner of sicknesses, and cast demons out of those who were possessed. Jesus' fame went throughout all Syria.

Matt 8:16-17 With a word, Jesus cast demons out of many possessed by them. He took our sicknesses upon himself when he was whipped and beaten.

Matt 9:32-33 **A dumb man possessed by a demon was healed and could speak. When the demon was cast out of him, healing came.**

Matt 17:15-21 A father cried, My son is a lunatic, for often times he falls into the fire or water to hurt himself. Jesus answered, This kind comes out only by prayer and fasting.

Why does today's church NOT cast out demons?

1. They are not obeying Christ's command to cast out demons, and are in sin for not obeying. See Mk 16:16-20.
2. They are proudful, and will not believe that there could be evil spirits (demons) living in their bodies. They make the excuse that Christians can't have demons, even they read how Jesus cast demons out of believers.

3. If a person has demons that torment them, they will be hard pressed to find a church or minister to help them.
4. **Only pride will keep a man from admitting that he has a demon tormenting him with nicotine, anger, alcohol, depression, sex lust, etc., etc.**
5. There are two choices: a man can humble himself and seek help to get delivered, or he can keep his demons and be tormented for the rest of his life.

Paul's Remedy: He humbled himself.

Acts 9:1-22

Like the apostle Paul, men must humble themselves and admit that they have been a long time deceived by doctrines of demons. Paul's deception caused him to destroy believers. **The "Pharisee of Pharisees" had been duped by Jewish false doctrine and religion.** Paul greatly humbled himself, admitting his sin and guilt. He lay blind for 3 days, crying out to God to forgive him and to save his soul. What a powerful, seductive control these demons had over Paul to cause him to hate believers. Only full obedience to Christ's commandments, obeying him to the letter, can keep the church free of seducing spirits. **Because Paul humbled himself, God gave him great power to preach the gospel, heal the sick, and to cast out demons.**

Power in the early church and the Book of Acts

Mk 16:14-20

After Christ's resurrection, He gave this command, Go into the world and preach the gospel. These signs shall follow them that believe; **they shall heal the sick and cast out demons.** The early church obeyed Christ's command.

Acts 8:5-8

Philip, a deacon and evangelist, went down to Samaria, and preached Christ to them. The people gave heed to him, seeing and hearing the miracles he did. For unclean spirits, crying with loud voices, came out of many that were possessed

Acts 21:8-9	<u>with them;</u> and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed. And there was great joy in the city.
Acts 5:15-16	Peter's shadow healed many sick folk, and them which were vexed (tormented) by unclean spirits (demons) were healed.
Acts 14:3 & 8-10	<u>Apostles Paul and Barnabas did many signs and wonders (miracles) by their hands.</u> A lame man heard Paul speak, and had faith to be healed.
Acts 16:16-26	A girl, possessed with a spirit of divination, was able to foretell the future and make money for her owners. So, demons are able also to prophecy, counterfeiting the work of the Holy Spirit. When Paul, discerning the spirit operating through the girl, commanded the demon to leave her, she could no longer foretell the future. Her owners brought Paul and Silas to the magistrates who beat them with many stripes, and had them both imprisoned. They sang songs and praised God. God caused an earthquake to open the prison doors.
Acts 19:11-12	God did special miracles by the hands of Paul. <u>Paul anointed handkerchiefs and gave them away to the sick.</u> Their diseases left them, and evil spirits came out of them. Many excuse their lack of power to heal by saying Paul was sick with a thorn in the flesh. It is interesting to see that he still had power to heal others.
2 Cor 12:1-12	
Acts 19:13-19	Seven sons of Sceva, a Jew, following the example of some Jewish exorcists, commanded an evil spirit to come out in the name of Jesus, <u>which Paul preached.</u> <u>The evil spirit answered, Jesus I know and Paul I know, but who are you?</u> <u>The evil spirit jumped on them and beat them up. They fled naked and wounded, and fear fell on all.</u>
John 7:37-39	How will the church know it has the baptism of the Holy Spirit? <u>By tongues alone?</u> No! But when signs and wonders follow, the power from God

to heal the sick and to cast out demons, then the church will be able to declare, We have been baptized into the fullest measure of the Holy Spirit.

Here on earth, when a man makes a final will and testament, no man can change it without receiving a just punishment. **How much more so when a teacher changes the scripture to suit his own ideas (Deut. 4:2; Prov. 30:5-6). Make no mistake, heresy is listed among other gross sins against God and will also never be tolerated.** In the end, even the most acclaimed false teachers who have passed on will find themselves outside the kingdom of God (James 3:1). Our Heavenly Father will not be mocked. Whatsoever a teacher sows in his ministry, he will reap in the end of his life. I say it one more time, in **1 Tim 4:16, apostle Paul tells his son in the faith Timothy to take heed unto himself and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this you shall both save yourself and those that hear you. Is it any wonder that Jesus said in Matthew 7:13-15 that few among those seeking to enter the kingdom of God will be able to?** Be diligent, therefore, to treasure the word of God and to ever preserve it as written. For it is written in the Proverbs of wisdom:

“O ye simple, understand wisdom: and, ye fools, be ye of an understanding heart. For my mouth shall speak truth; and wickedness is an abomination to my lips. All the words of my mouth are in righteousness: there is nothing froward or perverse in them. They are all plain to him that understands, and right to them that find knowledge. **Proverbs 8:1-9**

How We Got Our English Bible

1. In the 1380's AD, **John Wycliffe** and his associates translated the Latin bible, called the Vulgate, into English.
2. In the early 1500's AD, **William Tyndale** translated portions of the Old and all of the New Testament directly from Hebrew and Greek texts into English.

3. In 1535 AD, **Myles Coverdale** had supplemented Tyndales translation with his own to produce the first complete printed bible in English.
4. In 1604 AD, the English **King James I** authorized 47 bible scholars to use the many translations known at the time to formulate a translation free of any error. After 7 years of diligent work, the scholars met together to compare each man's work. It was perfect. **For the last 400 years , the King James Bible has been the most correct translation from the original Hebrew and Greek texts of God's word.**

What the Bible Is: Taken from Dake's Annotated Bible

The Bible is God's inspired revelation of the origin and destiny of all things. **It is the power of God unto eternal salvation and is the source of present help for body, soul, and spirit. It is God's will and testament to men of all ages**, revealing the plan of God for man here and now and in the next life. It is the record of God's dealings with man; past, present, and future. It contains God's message of eternal salvation to all those who believe in Christ, and eternal damnation to those who rebel against the Gospel.

It is the book that contains the mind of God, the state of man, the way of salvation, the doom of sinners, and the happiness of believers. Its doctrines are holy, its precepts binding. **Here Heaven is opened and the gates of Hell disclosed.** Christ is its grand subject, our good its design, and the glory of God its end. It is given to you in this life, will be opened at the judgment, and will last forever. It involves the highest responsibility, will reward the least to the greatest labor, and will condemn all who trifle with its sacred contents.

The Bible was given to man through the audible voice of God (Matt 3:16-17), through angels (Heb 2:2), through the prophets (Acts 3:21), through Jesus Christ (Heb 1:1-3), and the apostles (Acts 1:2).

It came through visions (Isa 6:1-5), dreams (Matt 1:20-21), revelation (Gal 1:15-16), and inspiration (2 Tim 3:15-17).

The Bible contains wonderful unity throughout its writings. Over forty different authors wrote the sixty-six books of the Bible during a period of over 1,800 years; and they all had one theme, the creation and redemption of the human race by God through Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit. These books of the Bible were written by men from all walks of life such as kings, priests, judges, lawyers, princes, shepherds, soldiers, musicians, singers, poets, preachers, prophets, fishermen, farmers, tent makers, publicans, physicians, rich men and poor men. They were written in various lands of three continents - Europe, Asia, Africa. **They were written in different ages and by many men, some who never saw each other,** or knew what the others wrote on the same subjects, yet when their writings became one book, there was not one contradiction among them.

Man could not have written the Bible by himself, nor would he have written it if he could. We know that good men must have written the Bible. **The writers claim to be inspired by God and were either inspired or simply liars.** If they were liars, then bad men must have written it, and such is contrary to every known human trait. **The Bible condemns all sin,** and this no evil man would do. Some of the Bible writers recorded their own sins, which brought them into disgrace. No man would so expose himself unless divine power moved him to do so that others might profit. Only a good man would submit to such a revelation of his own life. If good men wrote the Bible and said they were inspired by God then it is an inspired book.

All of man's needs are met by the Bible. This has been true of all ages. **Every promise in God's Word has been fulfilled in the lives of men who have met the conditions,** and so it must be from God who supplies these needs and fulfills his promises.

Miracles also prove divine revelation of the Bible.

Hundreds of miracles are recorded in Scripture, which only God could have brought about. Millions of men have been healed of disease and saved from sin through the centuries by obedience to the word of God. **This cannot be said of any other book.**

The Bible itself claims to be the word of God.

Over 3,800 times expressions such as, “Thus saith the Lord”, “The Lord spake”, “The Word of the Lord came unto me”, etc. are found. These writers lied this many times and more if they did not tell the truth.

The doctrines of the Bible are both strange and contrary to man’s teachings and philosophies.

The Bible says that if we want life, we must be willing to lose it first; if we want to be exalted, we must humble ourselves first; if we want to make Heaven, we cannot work good works to reach it, but must through faith, receive its entrance by grace. If we want to be great, we must become as servant to all; if a man thinks he is somebody, he is nothing from the standpoint of the Bible. If we are dead in our trespasses, we must be born again, and so it continues with basically all principles and ways of life according to the Bible.

This is why a man, to be saved and remain saved, must learn the Bible through and through and practice all of its commandments. To accomplish this great task, God has given men apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors, and teachers to both preach and teach the Word of God. The Bible says that many perish for their lack of knowledge of its holy contents, **and that many miss entering the narrow gate for their ignorance of the whole of God’s Word.**
